


WOMEN IN TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

Making Changes' Women in Technology Program (WIT) is a six-month integrated skills training program that effectively combines education, professional exposure, and experience by providing employability skills upgrading, technical training (Full Stack Web Development), and hands-on work experience to produce employment outcomes for unemployed or underemployed immigrant and Indigenous women in Calgary. The objective of this program is to increase women's participation in the technology sector by reducing barriers resulting in their economic independence.
